In Years 11 and 12 all students undertake the International Baccalaureate Diploma Programme (IBDP). We are committed to the care, safety, and wellbeing of all children attending the school.

All students at Sophia Mundi from Class 3 to Year 10 learn a musical instrument and take part in weekly ensembles. All students from Class 1 to 10 receive weekly Classroom Music lessons. Students in Year 11 and 12 have the option to undertake the IB Music Diploma. Our comprehensive music program is supported by a strong music faculty of exceptional musicians and music educators.

For the Instrumental Music Tutor - Cello position, we are seeking a someone to join the music faculty with the following experience and qualifications:

- Teaching individual cello students from beginner to advanced (approximately 20 students per week)
- Highly experienced teaching Classical, folk, and contemporary repertoire and technique
- AMEB exam and IB Music Diploma preparation
